



## Goodphil 2010 Information

Updated March 14, 2010

### A. General Information

- March 19-21, 2010
- Texas A&M University, College Station

### B. Registration/Check-In:

- Friday, March 19, 2010. 5:00PM – 7:30PM. Exhibit Hall, Rudder Tower.
- Pick up giveaways, event program, schedule
- Wristband must stay on for entire weekend (access to backstage, REC, club)

#### 1. Check-In / Pre-Paid Registration

- Bring school ID or Driver's License

#### 2. Late Registration / Late Payment

- \$55 cash only
- Will only be accepting dance participant registration
- (Late sports registration will be accepted on Saturday)

#### 3. No registration will be accepted after 7:30PM.

### C. Opening Ceremonies

- Friday, March 19, 2010. 7:00PM – 11:00PM. Rudder Auditorium.

#### 1. Rules and Regulations

- Start promptly at 7:00PM
- Any dance participant arriving late after 6:30PM will be deducted 2 points.
- 2 points/participant
- Points will be deducted from the overall score
- Any dance participant arriving after 7:30PM will not be allowed to dance.
- NO PRACTICING ANYWHERE IN RUDDER TOWER UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
- NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED in the Auditorium.
- NO SMOKING OR ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION.
- No rough play, feet on seats, or balcony jumping.
- Videotaping for dances only, NOT GUEST PERFORMANCES.
- People videotaping guest performances will have tapes confiscated
- Police will be patrolling area
- Stay within designated stage areas.
- Dancers are allowed to start from off stage
- Be sure to review the stage dimensions!
- All performers should stay within their assigned section.
- No sitting allowed in the aisles

#### 2. Dances

- 3 minute minimum, 6 minute maximum
- 3 dances time total cannot exceed 15 minutes

##### 1. Cultural Dance

- Required by every school to participate in GoodPhil
- Can use flameless candles (NO FIRE)

##### 2. Spirit/Modern Dance

- Not required by every school

- Tasteful dancing (use best judgment!)
- Vulgarity: any material or behavior you find your parents would not approve of

### 3. Judging

- Each school must provide on president/president approved judged
  - Does not have to register to be just a judge
- Can't judge your own school
- Judges will not switch out between dances
- Judges will report to the front of the stage at 6:30PM, Friday night.
- Dance results announced at the after party on Saturday and closing ceremonies on Sunday

### 4. Scoring

- 10 point maximum for each category
  - 4 categories (+ pts): Originality, Enthusiasm, Accuracy, Overall Performance
  - 1 category (- pts): Vulgarity
    - It is up to each individual judge whether or not they feel the material is inappropriate. A maximum of 5 points can be deducted from that particular dance score
- Throw out highest and lowest score and take average of remaining scores
- 1<sup>st</sup> place: 10 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: 7 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: 5 points.
- Penalties:
  - 5 points will be deducted from the individual dance score for going under 3 minutes or over 6 minutes for each dance
  - 10 points will be deducted from overall dance score for going over 15 minutes

### 5. Timing

- Timing will be done by 2 A&M/PhilSA representatives
- Starts: when music starts
- Stops: when last person exits stage

### 6. Backstage Rules

- One dressing room each for guys/girls
- A&M/PhilSA are not responsible for articles lost or stolen
- Must remain quiet once entering stage area

### 7. Dance Order/Music

- Here is the order of school performance for all dances:
  - Texas A&M University, College Station
  - UT Austin
  - A&M, Corpus Christi
  - UT Arlington
  - UH
  - UT El Paso
  - UT San Antonio
  - Baylor
  - UT Dallas
- If a school elects not to dance, then the order will skip corresponding school
- Each school is responsible for reporting backstage
- Before each dance portion starts, first 3 schools MUST be backstage: one on-stage, one in the wings (stage left/right), one in dressing area
- If a school is not present at time of performance, 100 points will be deducted from the school's overall GoodPhil score (before averaging) and will have ONLY five minutes to start their performance before disqualification
- All music must be separated on three CDs (one for each dance)
- Each CD must have: school name, dance order number, track numbers to play

- A&M/PhilSA is not responsible for scratched CDs so make sure music plays correctly
- Give three second beginning lag time at the beginning of each CD
- CDs MUST be turned in by 6:30PM to the stage manager
- A&M/PhilSA will return CDs after GoodPhil

#### 9. Parking

- Event parking free outside all lots
  - DO NOT PARK in: 24 hr reserved, 30 min parking, drop off, handicapped, service or business parking spaces
  - DO NO PARK: lots 100e, f, g, i, j and k. These lots are for a&m baseball use.
  - Garages are available and free
  - A&M/PhilSA not responsible for parking tickets
  - Look on the website for a map for available parking areas

- Follow standard IM rules (see GoodPhil Website under “information”)
- Officials have final ruling
- Leave the game on the court (When its over, it’s over)
- EMS teams ready to respond along with on-site medics
- Sports will start ON-TIME
  - Schools have 15 minutes to report to site before a forfeit occurs
  - Lost time will not be made up (tardy school will be penalized)
  - Anyone entering REC center must have wristband in order to gain access
    - If participating, must have the registration wristband
    - If spectating, must have spectators wristband
  - School Men’s Basketball Roster must be sent to the hosting school by March 5
    - There is no limit to the roster
    - When checking into a basketball game, individual must present a picture ID along with registrant’s wristband
    - If individual is not on the basketball roster, the individual may be added to the roster as long as the participant has a picture ID
    - IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A PICTURE ID, YOU CANNOT PARTICIPATE
- Optional Dance Workshop
  - Time and Place: Saturday, 2-5PM. Third Floor Rec.
  - Anyone may participate in the dance workshop
  - If individual is a GoodPhil registrant, only workshop fee will need to be paid

- If individual is NOT a GoodPhil registrant, a \$5 REC guest pass fee will need to be purchased on top of the workshop fee.
  - Even if you just want to watch, the guest pass would still need to be purchased
- Food and Drink
  - Food/Drink allowed only inside Garden Room/outside REC/on Penberthy Fields
    - however, beverages in plastic containers with re-sealable caps are allowed
  - GoodPhil staff will patrol REC
    - If found eating, school will receive warning (name, school name, signature)
    - Each school gets three written warnings before first/only official warning
    - Official warning will be given to school contact (GoodPhil staff to FSA Officer)
    - If three additional warnings are given, school will be liable to pay fine
      - IF AND ONLY IF A&M/PhilSA incurs fine from REC Center
    - Fine will be distributed to liable schools equally due within two weeks after GoodPhil
    - If you see someone eating in non-designated places, tell them to take it outside or to the Garden Room
    - Each school is responsible for own membership and representatives
- Points
  - 1<sup>st</sup> place: 10 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place: 7 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place: 5 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place: 3 points
    - no 4<sup>th</sup> place trophy will be distributed
  - Each school receives 2 points participation per sport
    - M/W/Co-Rec are counted as different sports
  - Deduction of 2 points if a school forfeits in 1<sup>st</sup> round
  - If a school has 3 or more forfeits in the 1<sup>st</sup> round, then 10 points will be deducted from overall GoodPhil score

- Admission fee of \$5 required (if not registered GoodPhil participant)
- Dress Code: Boys - No shorts, backward caps, do-rags, saggy pants, sunglasses, and hoods must be kept down
- DJs: DJ Ebonix (from KBXX 97.9 The Box, Houston) & DJ Elroy Boogie (from Kracker Nuttz)
- All night specials
- Announcement of dance winners
